How much storage do I need for a group site?

How much storage does a tenant have?

It means each tenant has 1TBstorage for files. And when you buy a subscription,it will contain a number of purchased licenses (assume as X). So,the storage of your tenant will be (10GB*X +1TB). Question 2. If I create a team,does it have the 25T storage by default? This number is limited by the whole storage of you tenant.

How much space does it take to store a movie?

Assuming the average movie is 1 hour 56 minutes long,1080p resolution,and stored as a h.264 MPEG4 video file,it would take approximately 5.085 GBof space. You would be able to store about 983 movies in 5 TB,or 1,901.02 hours. 25 TB allows us to store 4,916 movies,or 9,505.08 hours.

Why does a partition have more data than a filegroup?
