

How long is the power reserve of the watch?

In sleep mode, the power reserve will total 3 years. The power reserve of the watch can be displayed by pressing the button in crown position A for a duration of 6 seconds using the corrector pin included.

Do ultra-long power reserve watches keep resetting the time?

You won't have to keep resetting the time if you have an ultra-long power reserve watch. A watch's power reserve can be an overlooked function when buying a watch, but it's important if you wear multiple watches. When a watch's power reserve runs down, the watch stops keeping time, and you need to reset it.

What happens if a watch has a power reserve longer than 62 hours?

If a watch has a power reserve longer than 62 hours, you can take it off on Friday night after work and put it on again on Monday morning, and it will still be running. Why is power reserve important in a self-winding watch?

Power reserve is important in two ways. In a self-winding watch, when you're wearing it, you don't need a long power reserve because you're constantly winding it with your own movements, and even the minimum power reserve of 38 hours is plenty enough to keep it going when you take the watch off to go to bed.

Why does Panerai have a long power reserve?

The long power reserve is a Panerai characteristic dating back to its watches made for Italian navy commandos between the late 1940s and early '50s, at which time the brand wasn't making its own movements and used a hand-wound Angelus movement, the Angelus SF 240.
